Compacts Dominate Top 20 In U.S.

Through the first 11 months of 2007, 8 of the 20 best-selling models in the U.S. were compacts and 1 was a hybrid—the Toyota Prius, with sales of 167,009 units, according to the J.D. Power and Associates Sales Report. SM Last year in the same time period, only 4 of the 20 best-sellers were compacts and there were no hybrids. This year, the market leaders remain two large pickups: the Ford F-Series followed by the Chevrolet Silverado—both garnering more than 1.18 million unit sales this year. But the 8 best-selling compacts outpaced the trucks by more than 450,000 units, capturing more than 1.63 million unit sales.

In sales rank order, the leading compact models were: Toyota Corolla (No. 6); Honda Civic (No. 7); Honda CR-V (No. 10); Chevrolet Cobalt (No. 11); Toyota Prius Hybrid (No. 13); Ford Focus (No. 15); and Ford Escape (No. 20). Toyota had 6 of the top-selling models through November, followed by Ford and Honda—each with 4 models. The Ford models in rank order were: F-Series, Focus, E-Series and Escape. Honda's 4 models in the top 20 in rank order were: Accord, Civic, CR-V and Odyssey. There were 3 GM models, Chevrolet Silverado, Impala and Cobalt, in the top 20; followed by Chrysler LLC with Dodge Ram and Caravan and Nissan with the Altima.

Three Toyota models are new to the top 20 list through November: the Toyota Prius, RAV-4 and Tundra. Prius sales have nearly doubled from last year (167,009 units vs. 97,680 unit sales in 2006).
